Marylebone Cricket Club ("MCC") is the world's most famous, and most prestigious, cricket club. Founded in 1787, its home is the world-famous Lord's cricket ground in London. MCC revised the original Laws of Cricket in 1788 and continues to reissue them. MCC teams play many matches against first class and minor opposition and regularly tour overseas, as well as having an extensive fixture list every season throughout Britain, particularly with schools. The annual fixture against the Ship Inn is MCC's only match played on a beach.

This is the 5th year in a row that the Ship Inn have played MCC. The series score is 3-1 to MCC - the Ship's solitary victory in 2016 was followed by a reversal last year. All four games have been close-run affairs and we are hoping for another fine game this afternoon.

Playing regulations for each match

1. Each innings will consist of 30 overs per side.
2. Each player can bowl a maximum of 3 overs each.
3. Any batsman on reaching 50 runs is required to retire not out. Once all batsman have been out or retired, batsman who have already retired can return to continue their innings.
4. The pitch will be rolled immediately before each innings.
5. There will be a tea interval between innings. A short drinks break may also be taken after 15 overs at the fielding side's captain's request.
6. The boundary is as marked by any flags or boundary rope, or is the line of the incoming tide, whichever is nearer the striker's end.
7. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Ship Inn CC Captain is final.
